The Basics

Blackjack is a card game played between a player and a dealer. The goal of the game is to get a hand total that is closer to 21 than the dealer's hand total, without going over 21.

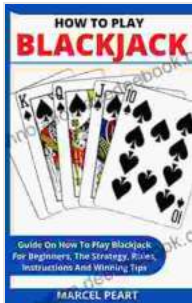

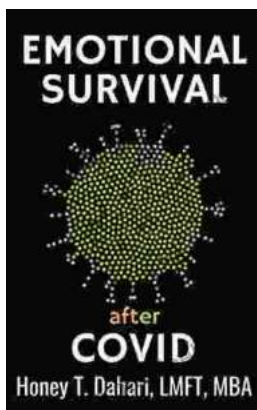
