Materials

- Size 10 crochet thread
- Size 10 crochet hook
- Scissors
- Yarn needle

Instructions

1. To make one rose, start by making a slip knot and chaining 4. Join the chain into a ring with a slip stitch.
2. Round 1: Chain 3 (counts as dc), dc 11 into the ring. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch-3.

3. Round 2: Chain 3 (counts as dc), 2 dc in each dc around. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch-3.
4. Round 3: Chain 3 (counts as dc), *dc in the next dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch-3.
5. Round 4: Chain 3 (counts as dc), *dc in the next 2 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch-3.
6. Round 5: Chain 3 (counts as dc), *dc in the next 3 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch-3.
7. Round 6: Chain 3 (counts as dc), *dc in the next 4 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch-3.
8. Round 7: Chain 3 (counts as dc), *dc in the next 5 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch-3.
9. Round 8: Chain 3 (counts as dc), *dc in the next 6 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch-3.
10. Round 9: Chain 3 (counts as dc), *dc in the next 7 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch-3.
11. Round 10: Chain 3 (counts as dc), *dc in the next 8 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch-3.
12. Round 11: Chain 3 (counts as dc), *dc in the next 9 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch-3.
13. Round 12: Chain 3 (counts as dc), *dc in the next 10 dc, 2 dc in the next dc; repeat from * around. Join with a slip stitch to the top of the ch-3.
14. Fasten off and weave in ends.

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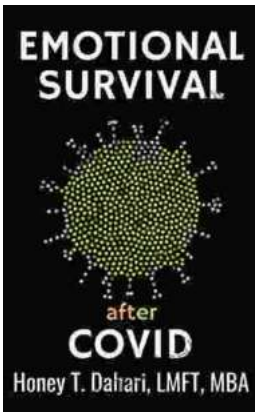
